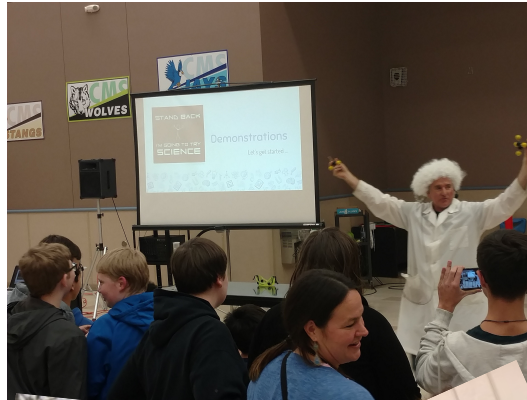

Know your Contract- Meeting and Prep times

The current contract can be found on the CEA website at <http://centennialea.com/contracts.html>. Section 11.7 includes the statement, "The District is guaranteed one hundred eighty (180) minutes a week for staff meetings, late start staff development, and other District directed meetings. Coaching session that are requested by members or directed as a Plan of Assistance will not count towards the 180 minutes, nor shall IEP or IEP related meetings or School Intervention Problem Solving team meetings. Once a month, a member may be asked to attend up to two hundred forty (240) minutes of meetings in a week. Weeks with less than five (5) working days will be prorated." There are specific sections after this for each grade level - check out yours and make sure you get your prep time!
